PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The ASDN ICE Centre is a career education centre that offers students an opportunity to explore a possible career paths while developing hands on skills. All courses offered at the ICE Centre are in collaboration with NBCC Miramichi. We have several classrooms and The IDEA Room at the NBCC Miramichi campus. Students will earn credits from their respective High School while also earning possible NBCC credits in their respective field.

Our objective is to provide students with the opportunity to explore a possible career path and develop a plan for their future.

Students entering any course at the ASDN ICE Centre will be treated as NBCC students. They will experience Post-Secondary Education and gain a better understanding of the independence that is required in life after high school.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Music Production and Songwriting course is designed to offer a personalized approach to music through collaboration with local musicians and industry experts. It is an opportunity for students in Grade 11 & 12 to further explore the field of music and develop their skills and understanding of music. A wide range of topics will be covered including the process of music production from songwriting to live performance, the business side of music and potential career opportunities.

Students will spend their time on four primary areas of focus:

- 45 hours ASDN Music Night
- 45 hours Personalized Music Project
- 45 hours Classroom Instruction & Demonstrations
- 45 hours Experiential Learning Opportunities
