PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The ASDN ICE Centre is a career education centre that offers students an opportunity to explore a possible career paths while developing hands on skills. All courses offered at the ICE Centre are in collaboration with NBCC Miramichi. We have several classrooms and The IDEA Room at the NBCC Miramichi campus. Students will earn credits from their respective High School while also earning possible NBCC credits in their respective field.

Our objective is to provide students with the opportunity to explore a possible career path and develop a plan for their future.

Students entering any course at the ASDN ICE Centre will be treated as NBCC students. They will experience Post-Secondary Education and gain a better understanding of the independence that is required in life after high school.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Intro to Nursing and Heathcare is a hands-on experiential learning course where students will explore a variety of career opportunities in the health care field. Health care is one of the largest areas of diverse career opportunities and has shown continued growth and stability.
