## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The ASDN ICE Centre is a career education centre that offers students an opportunity to explore possible career paths while developing hands on skills. All courses offered at the ICE Centre are in collaboration with NBCC Miramichi. All students will have the opportunity to meet with an NBCC Recruitment Advisor while also exploring other post-secondary options with their respective teacher. Students will earn credits from their respective High School while also gaining real life experience and meeting potential employers.

**Our objective is to provide students with the opportunity to explore a possible career path and develop a plan for their future.**

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

**Intro to Teaching and Education** is a hands-on experiential learning course where students will explore a variety of career opportunities in the Education field. Education has been identified as a sector that will be facing an employment shortage. This course is designed to give students an idea of what jobs in education are available and what those jobs may encompass. This course will help students explore possible Education career paths and gain a better understanding of the various options in the field as well as the post-secondary requirements.

The course will be structured as follows:

- 90 hours of field experience (Local Early Education Centres and ASD-N Schools)
- 90 hours of instruction
- You will receive 2 separate marks, one for Cooperative Education and one for Intro to Teaching and Education 110
